



## Thank you for purchasing the Futureglass **Classic 4 Way - Reception Knee Table!**

The design of Classis 4 Way allows easy tool free assembly by a competent adult.



You will need an allen key set to assemble the table base.

Please take a few moments to read these instructions to get the most from the table.

### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unpack all of the components, leaving the glass a protective layer (preferably still in the original packaging). The stainless steel boss in the centre should be facing up.

1. Assemble the Cross Base Section: -

Remove the large allen key bolt from the end of the leg. Align the slots in the leg with the base profile (you may need to turn 90 degrees for it to fit) and slide down over the base casting. Re-insert and tighten the large allen key bolt to secure the leg to the base.

3. Top section: - An adapter screw has been supplied for the top. Remove the blue packaging from the centre boss on the glass. Fully turn the adapter screw into the boss on the table top glass.

4. Turn the top up the right way and locate the screw in the leg of the assembled cross base. Rotate the top until resistance is felt, (be careful to keep the top 90 degrees to the leg to avoid stripping the screw threads ) continue to rotate the top clockwise to tighten.

The glass supplied is toughened to BS6206A for safety. In order to maximize this safety; please follow the following precautions.

| 1. Never drag the table - Always lift with assistance              | 8. Avoid subjecting the table to impact.  |
| 2. Replace any damaged glass with that of identical specification. | 9. Never sit or stand on the table.   |
| 3. Never place heavy objects onto the table.                       | 10. The table is not suitable for rough use   |
| 4. Use a suitable non-abrasive glass cleaner.                      | 11. Always lift the table by the glass to move it, never drag it or lift by the legs.   |
| 5. Take care when moving the table.                                | 12. In the unlikely event of breakage, a competent person must clear thoroughly the area of sharp shards of glass, which may cut. |
| 6. Take care in positioning the table.                             |   |
| 7. Never place hot pans onto the table.                            |   |
