The unit has been designed to offer years of enjoyment, providing these simple guidelines are followed.

The simple tool free assembly means that the unit can be constructed in the shortest of times.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unpack both bases by carefully cutting the tape.
2. Stand the assembled unit so that it is showing the red adhesive tape.
3. To add the base, clean the glass with the supplied alcohol wipe. With a clean lint free cloth or white unprinted kitchen roll, dry the area to ensure that it is perfectly clean.
4. Now hold the card template aligned with the base glass on the feet side (underside) of the glass.
5. Place one edge of the glass on to the tape first and ensure that it is aligned correctly and then gently lower the base.
6. The tape gains its strength with pressure, so apply firm pressure to the glass, ensuring that you do not topple the unit.
7. Holding the base, now turn the unit upside down and position. The tape will increase in strength over time. Do not move the unit holding only the base.
8. Add your favourite media to make a statement in your living area.

The glass supplied is toughened to BS6206A for safety. In order to maximize this safety; please follow the following precautions.
